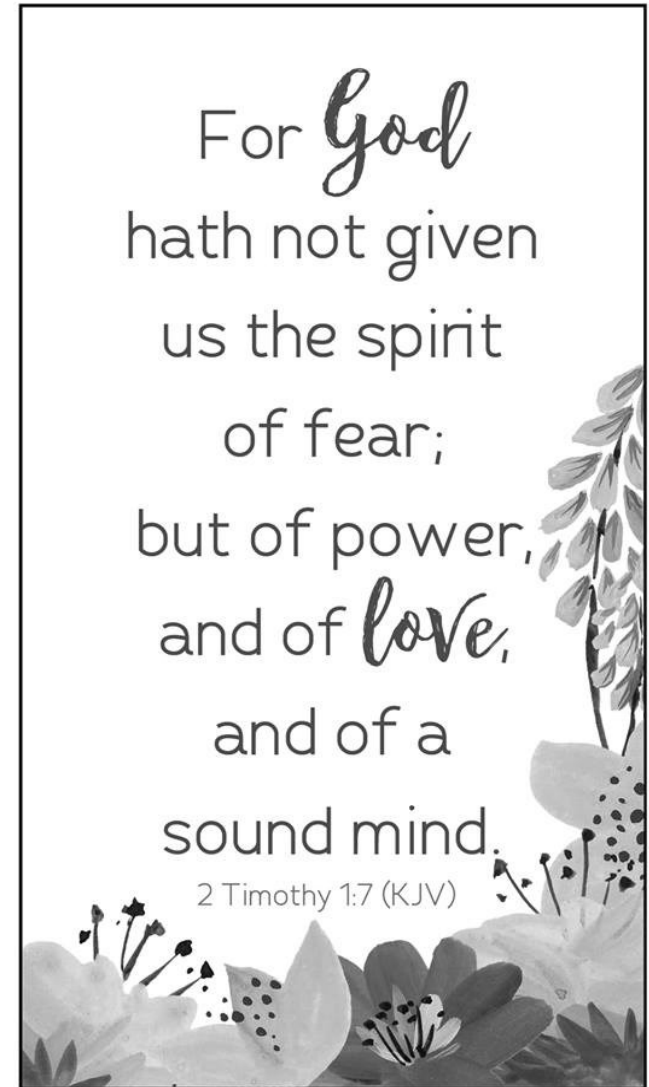

KYKD - God has continued to bless
KYKD! Despite some technical challenges, KYKD
and its translator stations continue to broadcast
the Gospel to the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta region
of Alaska. The summer "river ministry" to
villages and family fish camps continued this
year and the station received 100 additional
solar-powered radios to continue that ministry
into the future. Currently, they are working on
producing a Yup'ik language audio Bible for use
on the radio. The staff at KYKD are extremely
grateful for SBC's generous financial partnership!
