July Mission Spotlights

Ryan & Rebecca Stowell serve with CORD Ministries in Thailand. Ryan & Rebecca work with an Akha community. Many Akha people are not recognized as citizens by the Thai government. Together with the Family Connection Foundation, the Stowells have started Seed of Hope, a Christian-based dorm for Akha children. Because many Akha people are not Thai citizens they live in poverty & have difficulty accessing education. These children are at higher risk of being sold into child labor, slavery, or prostitution. The goal of Seed of Hope is to lead students to an relationship with God through Jesus Christ & to give children from remote villages access to public & college education & development of sustainable practices through planting crops, raising animals, & creating viable business opportunities - www.seedofhope.org.

Ron & Kim Linegar, as farmers & ranchers, reach out to Indonesia. The Christian church in Indonesia is very persecuted. However, God has provided people who are seeking Biblical truth where the Linegars minister. Many of these people were raised in 'church' yet do not know what a personal relationship with Christ means. The global church & mission organizations have ignored this area focusing on direct Islamic outreach. Having 4.5 million people open to Biblical truth is a huge opportunity that the Lord has provided. The Linegars provide pastoral education, Bible studies, VBS, English classes, & outreach to locals. They also train lay leaders, disciple nursing students, & raise teams to evangelize.
