July Mission Spotlights

Ryan & Rebecca Stowell serve with CORD Ministries in Thailand. The Stowells minister at Seed of Hope, a Christian based dorm for Akha children. Because many Akha people are not Thai citizens they live in poverty & have difficulty accessing education. These children are at higher risk of being sold into child labor, slavery, or prostitution. The goal of Seed of Hope is to lead students to a relationship with God through Jesus Christ & to give children from remote villages access to public & college education & development of sustainable practices through planting crops, raising animals, & creating viable business opportunities - www.seedofhope.org.

Ron & Kim Linegar, as farmers & ranchers, reach out to Indonesia. The Christian church in Indonesia is very persecuted. However, God has provided people who are seeking Biblical truth where the Linegars minister. Many of these people were raised in 'church' yet do not know what a personal relationship with Christ means. The Linegars provide pastoral education, Bible studies, VBS, English classes, & outreach to locals. They also train lay leaders, disciple nursing students, & raise teams to evangelize.
